KNOWING YOUR GOD-GIVEN ASSIGNMENTS

A God-given assignment is anyone God has entrusted to you and anything He called you to do.

Once your identity in Christ becomes clear, you must get clarity on your assignments as a Follower.

Every one of your God-given assignments will fall under one of the primary domains: your self, your church, your family, your work. Identifying jobs and people as God-given assignments is a game-changer. For example, seeing your family as a God-given assignment gives a great sense of purpose and responsibility. Or seeing your church as an assignment will take away the mundane part of attendance and push you to use your gifts/callings that God has given you. Don't worry about priority, just write down everyone God has entrusted to you and everything God has called you to do.

Think about it this way: What are the things in your life that, if you neglected them, would indicate you had not been faithful to the Lord?
